Until the end of the chosen session we are going to communicate with you on the application page so that you can follow any action regarding to your camping. Under the [PT-adminisztrátor megjegyzése\(i\)](#) you will find our messages in chronological order.

The 5 row about the payment will be filled out by us.

After sending the application, the system will automatically add the camping fee to the first row. This doesn't always reflect the reality; you may be getting discounts that will be added manually later by a PT-admin and it will be the first note in the [PT-adminisztrátor megjegyzése\(i\)](#) section. Your application will be confirmed by a manual e-mail as well, within two working days. First we check it and if we will have any questions we will also contact you about it. The manual e-mail will be sent to all e-mail addresses on the application form—with a link to it too.

If you receive this you can send the [payment](#).

We will receive the payment, that is normally [75 000 Ft/session/person](#) as a sponsorship fee. We ask you to send us an e-mail or give us a call when you completed the transaction.

We have to display a sponsorship invoice for every transfer. We receive the sponsorships independently of the campers, meaning that the sponsor when transferring, only needs to write 'SPONSORSHIP' in the notes' section. If you give us any other data, we will transfer the payment back, as we are not able to display an invoice via a 'deficient sponsorship payment'. The sponsorship fees will be identified by the data given on the application form (or afterwards). The invoices will be sent to everyone in the same time, in September, by post.

If you bring new campers, you can tell us their names later as well via e-mail or phone. We will add them to your application form.

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## What to know in advance of the camp

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### Dear PT camper!

Here you can read the most important information before the chosen session.

Everything is OK with your application, you will be part of the 2019 PT-vacation.

The dates of our sessions are the following (each session is from Sunday to Saturday):

### It's good to bring:

- pens/pencils, notebook, small dictionary (if you are learning a language)
- perhaps a pen drive (if you would like to do technology or photography)
- your favourite toy, from those times when you were small; your own story, either oral or written (if you will come for acting)
- one or more one-page screenplay(s) or show/programme idea; one set of white and one set of black clothes, and—if available—a make-up set (if you will do media)
- a few of your favourite stories or books by your favourite writer (if you chose creative writing)

- a camera (digital or analogue, whichever you prefer), cable/reader for transferring photos (if using digital), battery and charger, your favourite photography book or photo(s) (if you chose photography)
- athletic clothing and footwear (for sport and dance).

**You will definitely need:**

- a photocopy of your social security card
- the attached “Health and Parental Declaration” form, completed and signed
- health insurance, if you have one; PEOPLE TEAM does not provide it
- a towel
- enough underwear/socks
- comfortable clothes—as if you were going on vacation and staying in a hotel (washing machines and washing assistance available only in emergency)
- shorts or skirts
- at least one pair of long jeans/trousers (for the evening programs)
- for sports programs: sports shoes/trainers (1 asphalt and 1 AstroTurf field, 2 sand volleyball courts and 2 AstroTurf tennis courts), and shoes that won’t leave marks on polished floors (i.e. for squash)
- a water-bottle that only you will use (from 2017 we will try to reduce—with great efforts—the amount of plastic bottles, water-bottles will be available to buy at the cafeteria too at a reduced price)
- some kind of sign or ribbon from which you will recognise your water-bottle
- sunscreen and a hat for the sun,
- a swimsuit and an extra towel for the beach.

Bed linen is provided for the campers—and we ask everyone to use it!

**You’re responsible for it. If you give it to us, we will be—but why did you bring it then, right?**

If you have a cell phone, musical instrument, or stuffed animal, you can bring it. And don’t leave your favourite ping pong paddle at home either, if you are a champion with it... We won’t encourage you to do something this way or another way and we don’t forbid anything either, but what you bring with you to the camp, is at your own responsibility until it is with you.

PEOPLE TEAM accepts no liability for any items of value (smart phone, money, jewellery, Nintendos, colour TVs, computers, Swiss cuckoo bird clocks, or nuclear reactors) except for those left with us in the cafeteria or with camp management. (We hope you feel that the cuckoo bird is a dangerous animal-it could bite anyone, and a nuclear reactor won’t fit in the lockers...)

We do not lock the rooms, because it’s impossible to deal with locks and keys for all the (young and young-at-heart) people. Instead, everyone has a locker for securing their valuables-if the locker key is lost, you’ll have to pay for a replacement.

**One day:**

The morning classes (for each chosen theme) begin at 8:30 and end at 13.15. Saturday and Sunday (double sessions) partially deviate from the normal schedule.

In the afternoon there are many optional programs, in the evening we usually organize a big tournament or team games for everyone. Curfew at 22:00... Sometimes a bit later.

**First and last days:**

You can arrive on the first day of each session from 9am. We’ll wait for you with sandwiches (from noon) and the official camp opening ceremony is at 15:00. Those who chose language sessions will

have to write a test at arrival—or after the welcoming ceremony the latest—so that we will know what group they will be put to. The first group meal will be dinner.

On the last day the campers will be fed breakfast and sandwiches. We ask the campers who will be leaving with their parents leave after 1pm, as the rooms must be vacated, bed linens stripped and turned over and the camp readied for the next session. If you're staying for multiple sessions, of course you do not need to go home. Neither do we.

### **Food:**

In addition to breakfast and dinner, there are unlimited fruits and vegetables (apples, oranges, bananas, peaches, plums, carrots and cucumber and others) always available for the campers. There is a salad bar, but no soup. There's never soup. Never, but always. Anyone who would like soup can ask all day in the cafeteria (there will be at least 6 options to choose from), for a symbolic price of 50HUF for each portion. Same with pizza crackers, rice and bagett too.

### **We beseech and implore you:**

On account of our repeated experiences with 'bearded pizza' and 'legged meatloaf', we ask that grandmothers not send along treats for the campers. Because while we have a fridge in each room, the children don't know how/want to manage their own food. We ask you not to send even chips or other less crazy foods, lest they end up tangled and crushed in the bed linens. (We don't mean to scare, but we're often horrified when it comes to food in rooms!)

Anyone, who is hungry should say so! Eat more, ask for something else, wish or want because you can do it. Seriously. For other choices or for a second plate or anything you can ask any time. If you are not satisfied, let us know! We are trying, but it is hard if we are not informed about something. Don't be afraid!

Not just for food, but throughout the camp in general, if you have an issue, say so! If you don't, we might not realize we could have helped!

The dormitory **strictly prohibits** the consumption of any food or drink in the rooms, so please limit your food consumption to the Hangar area, which will also help cut down on the accumulation of any trash.

In the camp we are recycling with the cooperation of every camper. We don't use disposable tools, we drink from returnable bottles and have selective recycling bins for collecting any recyclables. We ask for your help too to stay green by helping sort anything you can!

### **Cafeteria, spending money, barcode:**

The main logistics centre in the camp is the cafeteria. Soft drinks, meals, arrival gifts, prizes from the team events, something exciting is always happening here!

The cafeteria is, of course, run by PT. You can buy things here or cash back in any money left on your card (i.e.: the 3000HUF if you choose one session and not to travel by bus etc.).

The cafeteria works on a bar-code system. Each camper has their own card (name, code, birthdate and photo), which can be used to purchase food and that you can top-up any time. The money on the card can be taken out, the balance can be claimed at any time and the remaining balance and transaction reports can be requested at any time by email ([info@peopleteam.hu](mailto:info@peopleteam.hu)).

One of the main functions of the card deposit is to ensure no one carries cash. PT can only be held responsible for money placed on the card, but for that any time-if the card is lost, please immediately notify someone at the cafeteria (or Ater), and we will disable the old card and get you a new one.

### **Travelling by PT-bus:**

Those, who don't travel on their own, can choose our buses (through MB Travel) which go to Kecskemét on the first day of each session and return to Budapest on the last day. On the first days,

we meet at the buses at 11:30—departure is at 12:00. (The round-trip bus fee is 3000HUF—not included in the overall fee.) On the last days the buses will arrive approximately between 14:00 and 14:30 from to the camp to Budapest, to where they left from: 1097 Budapest, Fék u. 1–4.

Diószegi Betti (+36 20 285 8377) will be waiting for the campers and the parents.

Sometimes it can be a bit chaotic, no matter how prepared we are. But the bottom line is: we wait for everyone and every child will have a seat on the bus.

The arrivals will be divided into two groups: one will be for those who are ready to go (because everything is already in order) and a second one of those who still need to make a deposit/sign a form/pay their fee (i.e.-proof of donation payment). When the two groups are finished, only then will the buses depart. Until then you can place your luggage in the trunk of any bus (they both go to the same place). We'll do one last head count and then off we go!

The check out at the return is just as important, and you can do it at the same person: Betti. If you have any questions or problems, please reach out to them directly.

On the way back, a teacher will always be with the children. The same rule applies for the return trip: we wait for everyone. (The bus may also be delayed on account of traffic.)

### **Travelling on your own:**

For the parents of the campers arriving individually. The exact address: Neumann János Egyetem Homokbányai Kollégiuma, 6000 Kecskemét, Homokszem utca 3–5.

This is how you can get to the camp: From Budapest you need to exit the highway at the 85th km.

Right after the supermarket (Auchan, Media Markt), at the round-about you need to go right (towards Ballószög).

At the second round-about towards Homokbánya quarter (there is a Decathlon on the right) you need to turn right at the corner, where there are two bus stops, and from where you will see signs of Homokbánya Kollégium and Tudósház. This asphalt road already belongs to the Homokbánya quarter.

Arriving from the city centre (the Dunaföldvári road) you need to look for the direction of Ballószög and at the second round-about go towards to Homokbánya quarter.

### **Health/dietary special needs:**

In case of any special health or dietary conditions/sensitivities (diabetes, celiac disease, meat, vegetables, etc) please let us know! Camp doctors would like to know everything up-front so as not to be surprised. In case you forget to include this in your application form, you can always send it by email later!

### **Are you already here and want to stay longer?**

If you only chose one session, but you'd like to stay for the next one because you like the camp, just let us know—we'd love to have you!

### **Rules, policies, and interruption of the camp:**

By receiving/downloading this letter and filling in/sending the application form, all campers (and their legal guardians) agree to the terms and conditions specified in the camp rules and policies outlined on <https://peopleteam.hu>.

The dormitory and camp rules are there for the safety and security of all campers. Anyone who deliberately violates the rules will be sent home.



In the event of expulsion, we will not refund the camp fees, because compliance with these rules is a necessity for the safety and enjoyment of the camp by all the campers. No appeals will be considered in these circumstances.

In the even the camp is forced to expel a camper due to serious behaviour problems, there will not be any refunds.

If anyone should need to leave due to other reasons (sickness, family reasons, homesickness, dissatisfaction), or if one does not arrive at all, a pro-rated or full refund will be given, as per the PEOPLE TEAM guarantee.

**At the camp:**

In case we are unable to reach them immediately, you can leave your number and we will have your child call you back as soon as we can.

We have Internet at the camp, and the children will have access to it.
